Emergency Med. Kit FAR-121

One approved emergency medical kit in aircraft for which a flight attendant is required

The medical equipment is defined by the FAR, JAR and NAA requirements. The requirements prescribe the minimum mandatory standard. It is always the airline decision to select advanced configurations regarding contents in order to provide cabin crew and voluntary physicians with a wider range of equipment, thus saving many lives in an emergency medical situation. Innovint kits are based on a modular system and comprise mandatory basic kits as well as advanced and customized configurations.

Automated External Defibrillator - AED

Automated external defibrillators (AEDs) are required by FAR-121, subpart X for airplanes for which a flight attendant is required and with a maximum payload capacity of more than 7.500 pounds.

Also airplanes operating under NAA or JAR-OPS regulations have more and more AEDs voluntary on-board.

Innovint supports the integration of AED as a standard equipment. Below picture shows a combination of a EU-OPS and FAR 121 standard first aid kit with an AED stored in one box.

The contents of first aid kit PNR 6240-48 is reduced for FAR-121 requirements only.

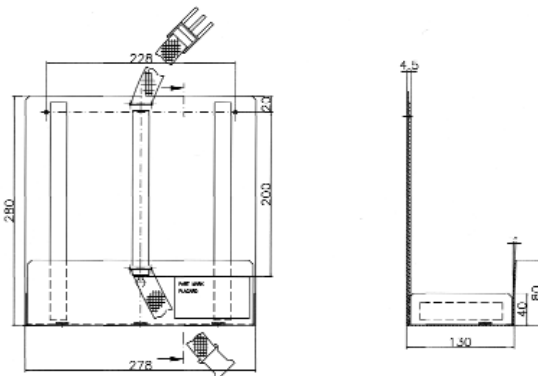
The kits are manufactured of aluminum sheets (coated in grey) and aluminum sections. The latches can be sealed by tie raps, plombs, or lockers.

Standard Body *First Aid Kit*

The first aid kit PNR 6240-35 was especially designed to be stored in the overhead stowage compartment, consuming as little space as possible.

The kit is manufactured of aluminum sheets (coated in grey) and aluminum sections. The latches can be sealed by tie raps, plombs, or lockers.

The first aid kit PNR 6240-45 is made of a more light weight box (coated in white) and Airbus single aisle standard layout equipment. Form Fit and Function are identical to 6240-35.

The anticipated shelf life is 18 months, which may be reduced down to 12 months due to the availability of medicine production lots.

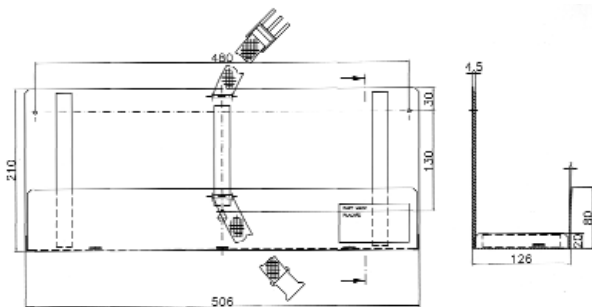

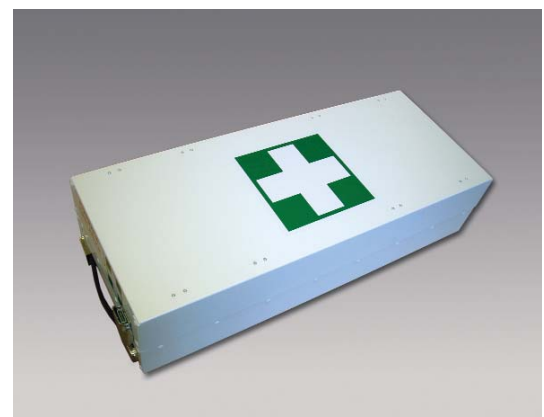

Long Range *First Aid Kit*

The long range first aid kit PNR 6240-31 gives high degree of flexibility for contents customerization. Half of the size is required to comply with the EU-OPS and FAR-121 requirements. The other half can be equipped to the airliner needs. The -xx PNR will change accordingly (PNR 6240-31 shown). The kit is manufactured of aluminum sheets (coated in grey) and aluminum sections. The latches can be sealed by tie raps, plombs, or lockers.

The long range first aid kit PNR 6240-41 is made of a more light weight box (coated in white) and Airbus long range standard layout equipment, Form Fit and Function are identical to 6240-31.

The anticipated shelf life is 18 months, which may be reduced down to 12 months due to the availability of medicine production lots.

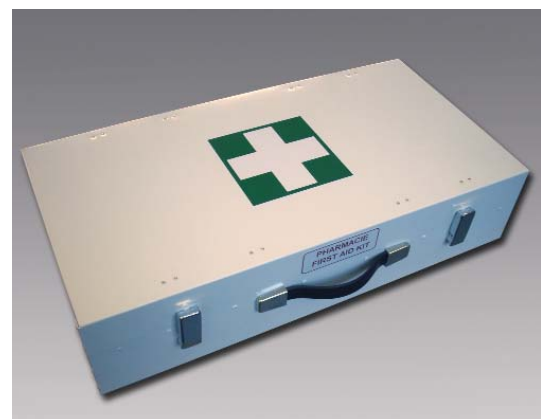

Basic EASA Emergency Medical Kit

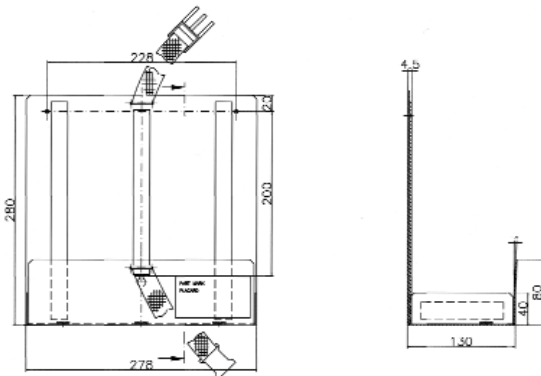

The contents of the emergency medical kit PNR 6240-28 has been assembled strictly to the statutory requirements of EU-OPS 1.755 and FAR 121 Subpart X including latest amendment. The emergency medical kit represents the minimum mandatory standard.

The upper compartment is equipped with an ampoule rack which holds up to 33 ampoules and sundry items. The lower compartment is divided into sections grouping the items by medical subject. The sections are marked by different colors, to enable the user to notice them quickly.

The anticipated shelf life is 12 months, which may be reduced down to 9 months due to the availability of medicine production lots.

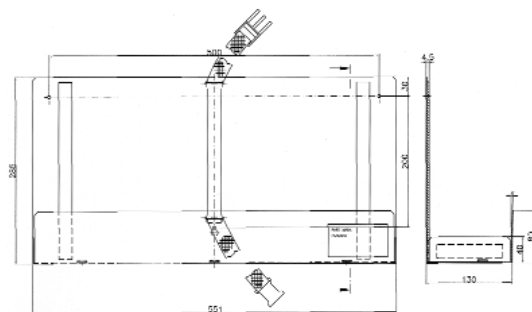

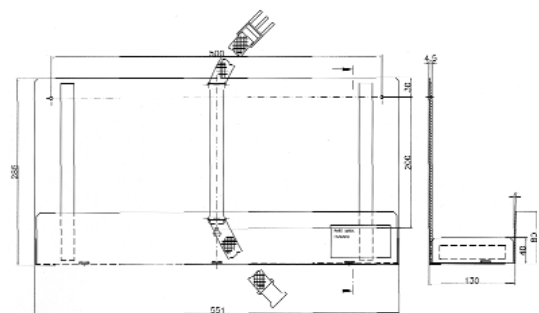

The attendant kit PNR 6240-81 provides for the cabin crew the “all flight” necessary first aid sundry items.

The certified first aid kit does not need to be used, which avoids the removal of the first aid kit from the aircraft and mandatory part inspection.

The soft pocket is made of red Nylon with a zipper. The below listed contents may be extended by some standard medicine, e.g. such as remedy for wounds, nasal decongestant, or loperamide.
